Dear Mr. Holladay:

The Manhattan District has created a Medical Section for the purpose of safeguarding the health of those persons working on its projects.

This group is composed of **Dr. Stafford L. Warren**, the Section Chief, who will direct the medical program and supervise the activities of the other members; Major H. L. Friedell is the Executive Officer and will aid Dr. Warren in carrying out and administering the program; Capt. John L.
